Building Permits/Fence Permits: Building permits are required for any building or accessory building



larger than 10 x12 feet. Only two accessory buildings are allowed on one residential lot. Permits are required for installing fences. Permits required if replacement of roofs include replacement of the decking. Contact City Hall for further information. Ph: 816-829-4012

Leash Law: City enforces the leash law. Please be conscious of the nuisance a dog running at large can

cause for the pedestrians. Owners of the dog(s) running at large will be ticketed. If you want to report a lost dog, dog running at large or any Animal Control issues call City Hall 816-829-4012 Monday thru Thursday 8-4pm; after hours, weekends and evenings call Cleveland Police Department 816-829-4014. If you take a picture with date and time stamp, the owner of the dog at large will be cited.

Large/Bulk Item Pickup Requires Pre-Scheduling: <u>Please Call ahead</u> (913) 837-4637 to inform Waste Management (WM) if you are putting out a bulk item for pickup. Residents are allowed to place one bulk item on the first Thursday of the month; trash /recycling pickup is on Wednesdays. If you want to get alerts about change in a scheduled pick up day; please submit your phone number or email to WM by creating an account.

From The Desk of Emergency Management Director

Tornado Siren: During the storm season the City of Cleveland implements the monthly Outdoor Warning Siren tests on **second Wednesday of each month at noon**, unless inclement weather is forecast. Two separate siren wails will be tested. The first wail is a *steady* sound warning citizen of an approaching tornado; the second is a *fast wail*, which warns citizens of an emergency situation where further information will be provided to citizens. Officials emphasized that the system is only to inform people who are outside and is not designed to be heard indoors. Residents are urged to buy a weather radio for inside homes and businesses.

Guidelines for helping you & your family prepare for severe weather:

Develop a severe weather plan and have frequent drills. PLAN AHEAD - KNOW WHERE TO GO!! Make special provisions for disabled or elderly family members.

If your home doesn't have a basement, seek shelter in one of Cleveland's safe areas or ask a neighbor to share their basement with you & your family if they have one. (Safe Areas listed below)

If you are uncertain about the safe areas that you can go to, please call City Hall (816-618-3412) or the Fire Department. (816-618-3998)

Remember: Basements offer the best protection.

If you do not have time to safely travel to a safe area and you do not have a basement, you should use interior rooms or hallways on the lowest floor and away from windows.
